## Information and actions on the illness S34M Page 1/2

It has come to our attention (via studies done by Swedish Gov. and SSCA) that anti-democratic and society-doubting individuals in 90% of the cases suffers from a newly discovered psychiatric disorder called "S34M".

The symptoms in the early stages are still somewhat unknown, however individuals with fully developed S34M have some or all of the follow symptoms/behaviors:

- 1. Strong Paranoia Which often leads to great missbelief in the people around them and society.
- 2. Anonymity on internet/networks A unfounded fear of being watched or under surveillance.
- 3. Partially or fully disclosed use of cell phones.
- 4. Difficulty with authority figures and unable to accept democratic laws
- 5. Engaging/forming terrorist groups that poses threats to safety and democracy
- 6. Seek and recruit like-minded individuals "Outline" (Also know as "Darknet"/"Deepweb"/"Undernet")

This non-adherence and very dangerous behavior may harm and within time wear on the structure of our democratic society. If an individual starts to show symptoms of/or develops S34M, then he or she must immediately be taken to nearest hospital for a exam by qualified personnel (provided and educated by the SSCA).

To prevent even future development of S34M the individual will be placed in rehabilitation and set on proper medication (some personal rights will be taken away from the individual during treatment/rehabilitation). More info to come on exact medication and rehabilitation methods.

The Swedish Gov. now strongly considers that surveillance and examination of the spreading and risk of S34M development within the lands population. There will follow a extensive research during the 3 coming years with medical exams and evaluations such as:

- Newborn gets a life-prognosis of running the risk of S34M.
- Teenagers are classed as a high-risk group and shall be monitored (minimal daily surveillance 40%) by school and future organs set out by the SWE GOV.
- Young adults (20 years of age) are closely monitored (60%) the first 15 years until they reach the age of 35. If nothing abnormal is detected (such as: behavior at work/political views/interests) the individual is then placed in the low-risk group and is lowered to causal monitoring (1-3%).

When in suspicion that an individual is suffering from S34M he or she will be registered in the newly started system PT:UFS (potential threat: under full surveillance). The PT:UFS system, initially founded by the European Parliament, will be introduced into the Sweden system with immediate effect. The register will be managed by SSCA (The Swedish Safety & Control Authority). SSCA will also be responsible for future studies and development of the PT:UFS system in Sweden.

If an individual is questioning (in a highly critical or aggressive way) this new function in society, the individual doing this could be a victim of and suffering for the S34M illness. In so, pose a threat to the country's safety and democratic structure.

The individual will immediately be registered in the PT:UFS system (as a precaution) and an in depth investigation will be initiated as soon as possible.
